DEPARTMENTS OF THE SCHOOL

Pre Kindy

The Athena School Pre Kindy offers places to children aged from 3½ years. Our Pre Kindy prepares children for a smooth and easy transition to Primary School in a fun, creative and nurturing environment.

A strong emphasis is placed on creative arts such as craft and music, as well as physical activities which develop both gross and fine motor skills. Both indoor and outdoor play areas are provided

to allow plenty of space in which to learn and grow. Visits to the community garden and school library are enjoyed throughout the year.

Children are also introduced to reading, writing and numeracy skills. A range of activities has been carefully designed to encourage and develop a desire to learn. Alphabet games, number games and story time are held daily.





Primary School Kindy - Year 6



Upon entry to Primary School great care is taken to tailor an educational program that best suits the needs and well-being of each child. Academic progress is achieved in a happy and caring environment learnina where individual attention is given to each student.

Our school has a strong, phonics based reading program which takes the student from beginner level to proficiency, smoothly and easily. In this way a love of reading is nurtured. Our approach to Maths is very hands on and is designed to bring the world of numbers and measurement alive.

The ideal teacher/student ratio is no more than 1:15 to ensure that the children are given individual attention.

Students also participate in a range of activities and excursions throughout the school year which encourage them to be involved in their community and the environment. Clean Up Australia Day and Harmony Day are but two examples of these.

Helping students understand their studies and guiding them to use this knowledge in practical situations are of key importance. To achieve this we use the Study Technology™ of Mr. Hubbard. These study methods enable students to become self-motivated learners by teaching them to detect and handle commonly encountered study difficulties.



High School

Years 7 - 10

Athena uses the Study Technology developed by Mr. Hubbard, which identifies and overcomes basic barriers to learning. The emphasis is on students achieving a complete and thorough understanding of whatever subject they are studying. Students master the ability to study independently as one of the first actions on their academic curriculum.

In this way, they achieve certainty in their study and are able to apply what they know. Programs are carefully planned for each student, with the goal of providing a solid grasp of basics and a genuine love of learning.

Athena's High School classrooms are a hive of supervised activity where individual students are able to study at their own pace on projects and checksheets. A checksheet gives the theory and practical steps which, when completed, add up to the required knowledge of a subject. This is true competency-based education.

Quality Assurance



The Quality Assurance Division works closely with students, parents and teachers to tailor the most effective educational program for each student.

Happy students are those who understand their studies and feel a sense of achievement. It is the role

of Quality Assurance to help make that possible for every student by isolating and remedying any study difficulty students may encounter.

CURRICULUM

The Athena School follows the guidelines set out by the Board of Studies, and incorporates the following subjects into the school curriculum:

The application of Study Technology and educational writings of renowned educator Mr. Hubbard, in combination with a carefully prepared individual programme, small classes, a happy and productive atmosphere and a reason to learn, is producing very pleasing results.

Recent student assessments of word recognition and reading comprehension skills are testament to the effectiveness of Mr Hubbard's Study Technology:

- 83% of students are reading at levels above the norm for their age.
- 55% of our students are reading at levels well in advance of the norm; up to 2 and a half years ahead of expectation.
- 79% of students' reading comprehension skills are well above the expected norm for their age.







The Creative Arts

Art, craft, music, dance and drama form an integral part of life at Athena. From finger painting in Pre-Kindy to set design and choreography in High School, a broad range of media and creative expression are explored and encouraged. Excursions to galleries, museums and theatres are enjoyed and occasional workshops by visiting professional artists are attended with enthusiasm.

All of this culminates in the artistic highlight of the year, our annual concert, which is warmly anticipated by students, family and friends alike. Opportunities are given for every student to be involved in the performance, be it acting, costume making, set design, props, music, singing, choreography or dance. This is an enjoyable experience for everyone.





CHARACTER AND DISCIPLINE

Discipline and Personal Integrity

Qualities such as integrity, responsibility and respect for self and others are necessary for a happy and worthwhile life, and therefore guidance towards these qualities is considered an important role of the school.

The non-religious moral precepts contained in Mr. Hubbard's "The Way to Happiness" are used for this purpose. Included are:

- "Honour and help your parents"
- "Set a good example"
- "Be worthy of trust"
- "Respect the religious beliefs of others" and
- "Try to treat others as you would want them to treat you".

While the school is not run on authoritarian lines, positive control is used and self discipline is fostered through the use of the precepts in The Way to Happiness. The school has a zero tolerance on bullying.

At Athena we strive for friendliness and approachability between parents and staff to help resolve any concerns relating to the child's progress at school.
