## FROM THE PRINCIPAL, DR BRIONY SCOTT

Dear Wenona community,

We extend our congratulations to the Class of 2022 for their exceptional results in the Higher School Certificate. Each student can be enormously proud, not only of their academic success, but of the perseverance and strength they have shown towards the achievement of their personal goals.

A remarkable 94% of this cohort has received early offers to universities across Australia and overseas, the highest percentage in Wenona's history. The diversity and breadth of their dreams, the range of courses they are pursuing, including those destined for international universities of note, and the adventures they're planning for future work and travel, remind me that this cohort was never going to be constrained by old-school expectations.

A significant measure of our success is the diversity of pathways followed post-school. It takes courage to step out into the unknown as you follow your dreams, your hopes, your plans.

Wenona was ranked 25th in the 2022 HSC School Ranking. As a proudly non-selective school, we are delighted that more than 27% of our 2022 cohort achieved an ATAR above 95, and 47% achieved an ATAR above 90.

Furthermore, 25 students were nominated, and seven students were selected for the NSW Department of Education Showcases in the areas of Visual Arts, Drama, Music, Design and Technology, and Textiles and Design.



These exceptional outcomes are also the result of the unwavering support of our hardworking and gifted teachers, who are a tribute to Wenona. I would also like to thank the parents and guardians of the Class of 2022 for partnering with us in the education of their daughters and for their long-time support of the School.

We wish this impressive and determined cohort all the very best and will watch their progress with abiding interest.
