ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Fahan School offers girls a comprehensive curriculum with small classes that allow staff members to pay individual attention to each student.

The broad range of subjects available includes the study of French and Japanese from Years 5 to 8 as core subjects and as electives from Years 9 to 12.

In the Senior School, students in Years 9 and 10 have the opportunity to choose elective subjects to make up approximately one third of their courses.

As part of the Years 11 and 12 curriculum, Fahan enjoys a collaborative program with The Hutchins School and St Michael's Collegiate. This enables our girls to select from a wider variety of subjects, with over 50 on offer, and provides them with co-education experience before they go on to further study or work.

Ranked 'Top School in the State' by *The Australian* in 2012, 2013 and 2014, Fahan has a long and proud tradition of producing high academic achievers and offers unique learning opportunities that prepare girls for their chosen careers.

CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

Fahan offers its students an extensive co-curricular program which assists in the development of specific skills, confidence and commitment. Students can participate in activities such as sport, music, visual arts, performing arts, debating, public speaking, student leadership, community service, exchange programs and intrastate, interstate and overseas trips.

There are numerous offerings for the girls' enjoyment: sailing, rowing, horse riding, water polo, surfing, cricket, tennis, soccer, hockey, netball, basketball, touch football, tee-ball, softball, badminton, water basketball, athletics, swimming and cross country.

Outdoor Education, Camps and Exchanges

There is a strong emphasis on outdoor and cultural experiences: annual class camps from Years 3 to 10; co-curricular camps and exchanges; Middle School Canberra trip, France Study Trip, Japan Study Trip and South Africa Exchange.

The Arts

Fahan offers a variety of opportunities for students to participate in choirs, orchestras, private instrument tuition, School musicals, plays or backstage in the Production Crew.

DOOR-TO-DOOR TRANSPORT

Fahan School provides a daily, door-to-door, private bus service to help your child get to and from school safely. This service is available to all Fahan students and is operated by dedicated bus drivers employed by the School. Bus services operate in the Eastern Shore, Kingston/Blackmans Bay and Northern Suburbs areas.

RESIDENTIAL LIFE

Fahan offers a safe and stimulating environment for your daughter, within its Sandy Bay Boarding House. The Boarding House is located on the Fahan School grounds and only a minute's walk to the library, classrooms and sporting facilities. There are short-term and full-time boarding options for students in Years 5 to 12 and the small, secure, family oriented boarding community is a wonderful second home for the girls.
