JUNIOR PRIMARY | Pre-Kindergarten to Year 2

As your child begins their schooling journey, our Junior Primary provides an environment which is safe yet challenging, and filled with opportunities for Godgiven talents to emerge and grow. It's a place where students are known and nurtured by passionate teachers.

LOWER AND UPPER SECONDARY | Year 7 to 12

Our Secondary School students receive an excellent academic education, with all learning undertaken in the context of a Christian worldview.

We seek to partner with parents to provide a safe and nurturing environment in which students are presented with positive challenges and new experiences. We acknowledge that, as young adults, our students flourish under the guidance and support of committed and invested teachers.

As our Secondary students mature and develop the ability to think critically, they become people of character who are able to problem-solve in collaboration with others, and contribute positively to the School and wider communities in which they are planted.

UPPER PRIMARY | Years 3 to 6

Our Upper Primary students are given opportunities to flourish and thrive in a caring environment, as well as widen their understanding of the world around them.

Students are supported in developing critical and creative learning skills, and academic rigour forms a high priority. This is coupled with students' growing understanding of God's purpose for their lives, as well as their capacity to make positive contributions to both their school and wider communities.

Students in Years 3 to 6 benefit from the support and instruction of a classroom teacher, as well as a team of specialist teachers in the areas of Science, Languages (Mandarin), Music and Physical Education.

Leadership Through Service

Leadership development is an integral part of our students' learning experience at Grace. By offering a variety of opportunities to build leadership skills through the act of service, we seek to model the example of Christ, who led through his servant-hearted teaching.

From an early age, our Junior Primary students are encouraged to develop their sense of responsibility and citizenship through opportunities such as classroom helper roles, leading assemblies, being a 'welcome buddy' to new students and taking on leadership roles in class activities.

As students move through Upper Primary and into the Secondary years, more formal leadership roles include library monitors, school flag teams, canteen service, sound and lighting team (SALT), the tech team (TTT), student councillors, house captains and prefects. These opportunities enable our students to serve one another and our wider community, while playing a key role in developing life skills such as resilience, perseverance and collaboration.

- Our experienced music tutors provide quality one-onone tuition in a number of disciplines, including piano, drums, guitar, violin and vocals.
- Team Grace incorporates the many extra-curricular sporting opportunities available to our students, from rowing and swimming to netball, basketball and soccer.

- Secondary students, provides exciting opportunities for skill training, leadership growth, relationship building and physical outdoor experiences.
- Our community service and work experience programs are invaluable to students in developing their interpersonal and professional skills, as well as fostering a heart of service to others and contribution to community.
