CHILDREN'S HOUSE

Pre3Montes Playgroup Parent-Infant/Toddler Programme (0-3 years)

CYCLE 1 Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten & Pre-Primary (3-5 years)

A Children's House classroom is a gentle hive of activity – very different from traditional schooling environments. Cycle 1 classrooms are multi-aged grouped with 3, 4 and 5-year-olds, led by highly qualified teachers (Directors), supported by Teaching Assistants. Pre3Montes Playgroup is led by a highly experienced Playgroup Coordinator.

Perth Individual's progressive Montessori college:

- ★ Fosters social awareness and responsibility in children, allowing the child to interact with children of different ages.
- ★ Supports individual learning and discovery. The college centres on the individual needs of children and within this environment, new information is presented when the child is developmentally ready.
- ★ The Director/teacher is typically on a rug on the floor, or at a childsized table, giving full attention to one individual child at a time or a small group. Careful observation of the Director will show they are constantly on the move in a quiet way, as they respond to each child's needs.
- ★ Offers a safe, caring and supportive environment with a strong virtues program and an emphasis on embracing and celebrating cultural differences.



PRIMARY SCHOOL CYCLES 2 & 3

Pre-Primary and Grades 1-6

Children change dramatically around six years of age and Perth Individual's progressive Montessori college environment changes to meet their needs. The Multi-Age grouping continues and children work at their developmental readiness.

Children in Cycles 2 and 3:

- ★ Become intellectual in nature and begin to move from concrete to abstract reasoning.
- ★ Develop morality and imagination based on the reality they know.
- ★ Acquire knowledge and information effortlessly because of their innate passion for learning.
- ★ Learn through discovery and creative problem solving.

It is through the child's exploration, imagination and creativity that knowledge and concepts are understood and mastered.

In this classroom, there is still a lot of movement and work in small groups. Children may be sitting at tables or working on floor mats, working alone, in pairs or in collaborative group activities.

HIGH SCHOOL CYCLES 4 & 5

Grades 7-12

The Perth Individual High School program recognises the needs of adolescents, and the multidimensional approach to learning. The program is designed to be flexible, maximise access to resources and to optimise student learning opportunities via an individualized, integrated and thematic approach.
