JUNIOR SCHOOL – PREP TO YEAR 5

Junior School at Tyndale lays the essential foundations for learning through a strong focus on literacy and numeracy, in a caring and secure environment. Our aim is to encourage children in their personal relationship with Jesus Christ as they experience the adventure of learning.

MIDDLE SCHOOL – YEARS 6 TO 8

Middle School encompasses the best aspects of Junior School and Senior School to allow children the opportunity to develop and nurture their God given gifts, in an environment designed specifically to cater to the needs of students in Years 6, 7 and 8, and to help create a seamless transition to Senior School.

SENIOR SCHOOL – YEARS 9 TO 12

A wide variety of subjects is offered to cater for the needs of our diverse population of students. Within a biblical framework students are encouraged to explore and evaluate culture and to consider their own contribution. Strong pastoral relationships between students and staff assist young people as they move into adulthood.

Tyndale works with TAFE Vocational Education and Training to offer a wide range of courses, both on site and at nearby TAFE institutions.



TYNDALE – A PARENT CONTROLLED SCHOOL

Tyndale is a school where the authority and responsibility of parents concerning the education of their children are recognised and supported. The Association of Christian Education for Blacktown Ltd consists of parents, past and present, who declared their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and wholeheartedly subscribe to the Educational Creed of the Association.

Through Association and Board membership, Association forums, committee involvement and parent/teacher meetings all parents are able to express their interests and concerns regarding the education of their children.



SPORT

Each student is encouraged to participate in sport at the highest possible standard and a wide range of sports is offered each year. Tyndale plays representative sports through various organisations, including the Christian Schools Sports Association.

SCHOOL CAMPS PROGRAM YEARS 5-12

Tyndale has a camps program that fulfils a number of very important aspects of school life. Camps are part of the school curriculum and all students are required to attend. The cost of camps for Years 5-10 is included in school fees.

COMPUTER FACILITIES

Computers are in wide use across the school. The integrated school-wide network provides a variety of resources such as Internet and Intranet. These can be accessed via individual computers in classrooms and in the Library as well as from dedicated computer labs.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The School offers a variety of extra-curricular activities and these are seen as an integral part of school life. Of particular note is the school's Music program which includes instrumental tuition during school hours, Year 4 Band and a variety of instrumental and vocal ensembles.
