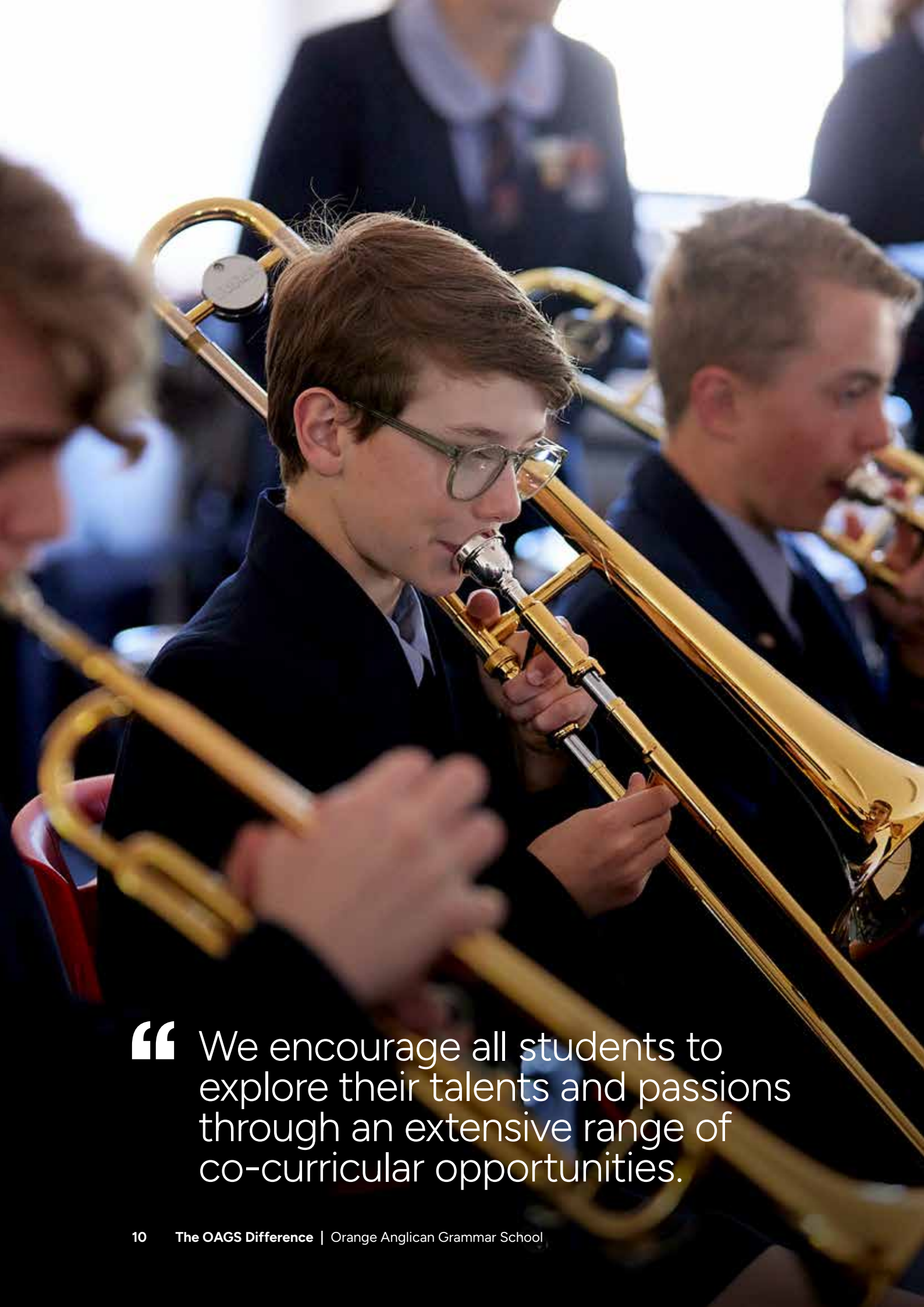
Pastoral Care
