We employ a variety of teaching methods to cater to diverse learning styles. ## Creative & Performing Arts

HopePoint is known for their incredible musicals, held every two years. Our musicals are grand-scale productions that bring together the entire school community to showcase students talents within the performing arts. Every student has the opportunity to be a part of our school musical, with students in Years 3-6 having the eligibility to audition for singing and speaking roles.



## Sport

Students at HopePoint are able to participate in numerous sporting carnivals and gala days at a school, zone and state level. Students not only have the opportunity to improve and showcase their physical skills at these events but also display a Godly spirit by displaying good sportsmanship both on and off the sporting ground. At HopePoint your child will be offered the opportunity to participate in many different sports, such as netball, soccer, AFL, dance and basketball.



## Clubs

At HopePoint, we provide a wide range of clubs and interest groups, catering to the different interests and passions of our students. ## Camps

# Wellbeing

We believe that education is about more than just academic achievement. We're committed to helping our students thrive not just intellectually, but also emotionally and spiritually. Our comprehensive wellbeing program is designed to provide students with the support they need to grow and develop in all areas of their lives.

## SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

We believe that every student should feel safe and supported at school, and we work hard to prevent bullying from taking place. We have policies in place to address bullying behavior. We also provide training to students and staff to help them recognise and respond to any scenarios like this. Our school is incredibly blessed and has extremely low rates of anti-social behaviour.

## PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM

We also run a peer support program. This program is designed to help students develop positive relationships with their peers and feel more connected to the school community. Peer support leaders are trained to provide emotional support and practical advice to their peers, and to help connect students with additional support when needed.

## SCHOOL COUNSELLOR

We have a trained School Counsellor who provides emotional support, guidance, and resources to students who may be struggling with a variety of issues. This could include anything from anxiety and stress to family problems. Our School Counselor is an integral part of our support team, and their presence ensures that our students have a safe and confidential space to work through any challenges they may be facing.

## CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Finally, we see Christian formation as the key aspect to positive wellbeing. We have weekly chapel services and morning devotion time. This time provides students with the opportunity to reflect on their faith and connect with God before starting their day. It's a chance to set a positive tone and to remind students of the values and principles that guide our school community.

## How to Enrol

- 1 INITIAL ENQUIRY & SCHOOL TOUR**

Families will be notified in person or in writing about the outcome. If offered a place, families will be notified in person and will receive a Letter of Offer with details on confirmation fees and how to secure your place.
